CHAPTER 71

AN ACT authorizing the board of regents of the state colleges to exchange state-owned lands therein described located in the city of Oshkosh to said city in exchange for certain city-owned lands in said city.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

The secretary of the board of regents of state colleges, with the approval of the governor, is authorized to convey that portion of the state-owned lands which are now a part of the premises of the Wisconsin state colleges described as follows:

“That part of Lot 2 of Block 130 in the Twelfth Ward, City of Oshkosh, per Leach’s Map of 1894, situated north of Congress Avenue and West of Beech Street commencing at the northwest corner of said Lot 2, thence east 122.62 feet, thence south along Beech Street 134.1 feet to Congress Avenue, thence northwesterly along Congress Avenue 118.1 feet, thence west along Congress Avenue to the west boundary of said Lot 2, thence north 97.1 feet to place of beginning, and

That part of Lot 3 of Block 130 in the Twelfth Ward, City of Oshkosh, per Leach’s Map of 1894, situated north of Congress Avenue and east of Beech Street commencing at the northeast corner of said Lot 3, thence south 185.9 feet, thence northwesterly along Congress Avenue 122 feet, thence north along Beech Street 147.4 feet, thence east 116 feet to place of beginning”;

under such terms, conditions and covenants as the secretary determines in exchange for certain city-owned lands in the city of Oshkosh.
