CHAPTER 15

AN ACT to repeal and recreate 100.24 of the statutes, relating to revocation of corporate authority.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

100.24 of the statutes is repealed and recreated to read:

100.24 REVOCATION OF CORPORATE AUTHORITY. Any corporation, foreign or domestic, which violates s. 100.22 or any order issued under

s. 100.20 may be enjoined from doing business in this state and its certificate of authority or incorporation may be canceled or revoked. The attorney general may bring an action for this purpose in the name of the state. In any such action judgment for injunction, cancellation or revocation may be rendered by the court, upon such terms as it deems just and in the public interest, but only upon proof of a substantial and wilful violation.
