CHAPTER 336

AN ACT to amend 20.945 of the statutes, relating to insuring certain state vehicles and aircraft.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 20.945 of the statutes is amended to read:

20.945 The several departments, boards and commissions of the state government are authorized to secure public liability, property damage and fire, theft and windstorm insurance for the protection of state automobiles, trucks and aircraft. Such insurance may provide public liability and property damage coverage for state traffic patrol officers and conservation department employes when, in the performance of their official duties, it is necessary to move other vehicles. The cost of such insurance by such departments, boards and commissions shall be audited and paid in the same manner as other departmental expense.

SECTION 2. This bill is declared to be an emergency bill, recommended by the joint committee on finance, in accordance with the requirements of section 16.47 (2) of the statutes.
