CHAPTER 451

AN ACT to create 16.79 (9) of the statutes, relating to the department of administration keeping current information pertaining to the organization of the state government.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

16.79 (9) of the statutes is created to read:

16.79 (9) To keep current the information pertaining to the organization of the state government, thereby continuing and supplementing the information initially furnished in a legislative council staff report (in loose form, with holes punched for insertion of plastic back elements) to the committee on efficiency in state government, on the organization of Wisconsin state government, issued in February 1963, state departments, agencies or officers shall furnish the department of administration on July 1 of each even-numbered year such information as the department requires. As soon as possible after July 1 the department shall republish the volume showing the current structure of state government and transmit copies thereof to the state departments, agencies, officers and to each legislator.
