CHAPTER 500

AN ACT to create 13.46 and 20.530 (29) of the statutes, relating to the creation of a joint interim study committee on county supervising districts and making an appropriation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 13.46 of the statutes is created to read:

13.46 COMMITTEE TO STUDY COUNTY SUPERVISORY DISTRICT REPRESENTATION. (1) COMPOSITION. There is created a joint interim study committee for the purpose of determining the best method of apportioning representation on a county board consisting of:

- (a) Two representatives of the Wisconsin town boards association selected by the board of directors thereof.
- (b) Two representatives of the Wisconsin county boards association selected by the board of directors thereof.
- (c) One representative from a city and one from a village selected by the board of directors of the league of municipalities.
- (d) Three assemblymen and 3 senators, selected by the legislative council.
- (e) Two citizen members selected by the legislative council.
- (f) The attorney general or his designated representative.

(2) ORGANIZATION. The committee shall first meet at the call of the chairman of the legislative council, and shall thereupon establish bylaws for its organization and operation and select a chairman, vice chairman and secretary from its membership.

(3) COMPENSATION. Members of the committee shall receive no compensation except their actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their duties.

(4) PURPOSE. The committee shall, as soon after its organizational meeting as possible, meet and draft a plan, for the apportioning of county supervisory districts on town, village and city lines, giving greater con-

sideration to population representation than does the present town, village and city ward representation, but not disregarding other factors. The plan drafted shall be more equitable toward population than the existing Wisconsin system. The committee shall recommend its plan to the 1965 legislature.

(5) RELATION OF LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL. The committee shall be attached to the legislative council.

SECTION 2. 20.530 (29) of the statutes is created to read:

20.530 (29) SUPERVISORY DISTRICT STUDY. On July 1, 1963, for the 1963-65 biennium \$2,000 for the conduct of the study proposed by s. 13.46.
