CHAPTER 529

AN ACT to amend 157.05 (1) of the statutes, relating to personal property held by cemetery associations.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

157.05 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

157.05 (1) A cemetery or religious association authorized to hold lands for cemetery purposes may take and hold not exceeding 80 acres of land, to be used exclusively for burial of the dead, and personal property not exceeding * * * \$250,000 in value, to promote the objects of the association; and if the cemetery is near to a city of more than 10,000 and less than 100,000 inhabitants the association may so take and hold not exceeding 160 acres of land; and if near to or within a city of 100,000 or more inhabitants not exceeding 240 acres.
