CHAPTER 531

AN ACT to appropriate \$12,500 from the general fund for payment of a claim made by Jay H. Hoag, Rodney J. Edwards and G. Arthur Johnson against the state.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

There is appropriated from the general fund \$12,500 to Jay H. Hoag, Rodney J. Edwards and G. Arthur Johnson to compensate them for legal services performed for the state, which services contributed materially to the settlement of the claim of the state against the United States of America, involving the swamp lands within the exterior boundaries of the Bad River, Lac du Flambeau and Lac Courte Oreilles Indian reservations, by which settlement the state recovered \$750,000. Acceptance of this payment shall operate as a full and complete release to the state for any claim on account of such services.
