**CHAPTER 59**

AN ACT to amend 20.530 (7) (a) (intro. par.) and (c) of the statutes, relating to the level of pay of assistant chief clerks.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. 20.530 (7) (a) (intro. par.) and (c) of the statutes are amended to read:

20.530 (7) (a) (intro. par.) Employees in the following readily identifiable positions of greater responsibility may be paid \$30 a month more than their grade and step level for a full month's service or a prorata part thereof for part of a month's service. *Except in the case of the assistant*

*chief clerk*, no employe shall be eligible for more than \$30 additional pay per month regardless of the number of such positions held, *however such assistant chief clerk shall not hold more than 2 such positions.*

(c) The person designated by the chief clerk as the assistant chief clerk \* \* \* may, at the discretion of the chief clerk, be paid \$60 a month more than his grade and step level for a full month's service or a prorata part thereof for a part of a month's service.

SECTION 2. This bill is declared to be an emergency appropriation bill in accordance with section 16.47 (2) of the statutes.
