CHAPTER 162

AN ACT to create 46.049 of the statutes, relating to a training school for delinquent boys under the direction of the state department of public welfare.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

46.049 of the statutes is created to read:

46.049 TRAINING SCHOOL FOR DELINQUENT BOYS. The department, with the approval of the governor, may purchase or accept a gift of land for a suitable site for an additional training school for delinquent boys and erect and equip such buildings as it deems necessary at such time as funds may be allocated for that purpose by the building commission. Such training school or other additional facilities for delinquent boys financed by the authorized 1965-67 building program shall be located north of a line between La Crosse and Manitowoc. Such institution when constructed shall be maintained and operated by the department for the treatment of delinquent boys committed to the depart-

ment under s. 48.34. All laws pertaining to the care of children received under s. 48.34 shall apply. Officers and employes of the institution are subject to the same laws as apply to other facilities described in s. 48.52.
