CHAPTER 23

AN ACT to amend 35.24 (1) of the statutes, relating to Blue Book biographies and pictures of state officers and legislators.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

35.24 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

35.24 (1) The legislative reference bureau shall compile, index, prepare and deliver to the director biennially copy for a book to be denominated "Wisconsin Blue Book," which shall contain ~~lists~~ *the biographies and pictures of state officers*, senators and assemblymen and ~~employees~~ *officers* of each house, and statistical and other information of the same general character as that heretofore published, but so selected and condensed as will limit the number of pages approximately to 800 or less. In making such selection the legislative reference bureau is directed to consult freely with the state superintendent and the director of the state historical society, and insofar as possible, make the book useful for civics classes in schools. The director shall deliver said copy to the contract printer not later than January 1 in each even-numbered year, to be printed and delivered not later than June 15 of the same year.
