

CHAPTER 287

AN ACT to create 20.850 (8) and 41.13 (10) of the statutes, relating to technical scholarships for Indians, granting rule-making authority and making an appropriation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 20.850 (8) of the statutes is created to read:

20.850 (8) TECHNICAL TRAINING SCHOLARSHIPS FOR INDIANS. Annually, beginning July 1, 1965, \$30,000 for technical training scholarships for Indians, established under s. 41.13 (10).

SECTION 2. 41.13 (10) of the statutes is created to read:

41.13 (10) The state board shall establish rules and standards governing a scholarship program for needy Indians and may grant such scholarships to eligible persons for study at such schools as the state board determines. No such scholarship to any individual shall exceed \$20 weekly.

SECTION 3. This bill is declared to be an emergency appropriation bill, recommended by the joint committee on finance, in accordance with the requirements of section 16.47 (2) of the statutes.
