CHAPTER 331

AN ACT to amend 26.12 (5) (b) of the statutes, relating to issuance of burning permits in extensive forest protection districts.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 26.12 (5) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

26.12 (5) (b) ~~During any time of the year when so ordered by the commission,~~ No person shall set any fire except for warming the person or cooking food within the limits of any extensive forest protection district ~~at any time during the months of January, February, March, April and May except when the ground is snow-covered and during any other time of the year when so ordered by the commission unless written permission has been received beforehand from a duly appointed fire warden.~~ The commission shall prepare the necessary blanks for this purpose, shall prescribe rules for the issuance of such permits, shall appoint, if necessary, in addition to the regular or emergency fire wardens, others who shall be authorized to issue such permits, and shall have jurisdiction over all other details concerned with or growing out of the closed season on the setting of fire.

SECTION 2. This bill is declared to be an emergency bill, recommended by the joint committee on finance, in accordance with the requirements of section 16.47 (2) of the statutes.
