CHAPTER 341

AN ACT to amend 194.04 (2) of the statutes, relating to expiration of motor vehicle permits.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

194.04 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

194.04 (2) Every permit, except the quarterly permits issued pursuant to sub. (1) (cm), for the operation of a motor vehicle expires on ~~June 30~~ *December 31* of each year. Except as herein provided application for permits shall be made annually and shall be accompanied by the annual fee reduced by one-fourth for each quarter of the permit year in which the vehicle has not been operated, except that there shall be no reduction of the fees paid by private motor carriers or on renewals. No permit shall be issued or renewed for any motor vehicle unless the registration required by ch. 341 is paid in this state.
