

Chapter 569

AN ACT to renumber 349.11 (1); and to create 349.11 (1) (b) of the statutes, relating to authority of state highway commission to determine and declare reasonable and safe minimum speed limits on highways.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. 349.11 (1) of the statutes is renumbered 349.11 (1) (a).

SECTION 2. 349.11 (1) (b) of the statutes is created to read:

349.11 (1) (b) Whenever the state highway commission with respect to the state trunk highway system determines, upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation, that any statutory minimum speed limit is greater or less than is reasonable or safe under the conditions found to exist upon any part of a highway or that the actual minimum speed of vehicles upon any part of a highway is greater or less than is reasonable and prudent, the commission with respect to the state trunk highway system may, subject to applicable limitations in subs. (2) and (3), determine and declare a reasonable and safe minimum speed limit on the highway or part thereof in question. When appropriate signs giving notice of such minimum speed limit have been erected and are in place such minimum speed limit shall be effective at all times or at such times as indicated by the signs.
