CHAPTER 68

AN ACT to create 59.715 (22) of the statutes, relating to the authority for the destruction of certain marriage records retained by the county clerk.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

59.715 (22) of the statutes is created to read:

59.715 (22) After 10 years records and papers pertaining to marriage license applications including antenuptial physical examinations and test certificates, consents of parent or guardian for marriage and orders of the court permitting marriage or waiving the waiting period.
