CHAPTER 115, LAWS OF 1967

AN ACT to create 16.60 of the statutes, relating to financial and management services provided for nonprofit corporations by the department of administration, and providing an appropriation.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. 16.60 of the statutes is created to read:

16.60 SERVICES TO NONPROFIT CORPORATIONS. (1) The department of administration may provide, on a reimbursable basis, financial and management services for nonprofit corporations with which the state or its agencies has entered into leases and subleases for the construction and leasing of projects. Services provided under this section shall be in accordance with the request of the state building commission as to the type and scope of service requested, the civil service range of the employe or employes assigned to them and the total reimbursement to be charged by the department of administration to the nonprofit corporations.

(2) The department or the legislature or any person delegated by the legislature may inspect and examine or cause an inspection and examination of all records relating to the construction of projects that are, or are to be, financed by a nonprofit corporation and leased or subleased by any state agency.

(3) The commissioner of administration or his designated representative shall serve in an advisory capacity to and be a nonvoting member of any nonprofit corporation with which the state or its agencies has entered into leases and subleases for the construction and leasing of projects.

SECTION 2. (1) On the effective date of this act, all permanent full-time salaried personnel then employed by the Wisconsin state agencies building corporation shall be transferred to and become employes of the department of administration under the classified service and shall have the same civil service salary as their base salary at the time of transfer.

(2) The commissioner of administration may assign or reassign the personnel transferred under sub. (1), but the salary of such personnel shall not be reduced because of their reassignment.

SECTION 3. The appropriation to the department of administration under section 20.125 (1) (a) of the statutes, as affected by the laws of 1967, is increased by \$11,804 for the fiscal year 1966-67, by \$84,818 for the fiscal year 1967-68 and by \$88,316 for the fiscal year 1968-69 for the purpose of providing funds for functions transferred under this act.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect May 15, 1967, or upon passage and publication, whichever is later.
