CHAPTER 121, LAWS OF 1967

AN ACT to create 47.05 (4) of the statutes, relating to the receipt of gifts by the department of public welfare of private funds to establish workshop and rehabilitation facilities for the visually handicapped.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

47.05 (4) of the statutes is created to read:

47.05 (4) PRIVATE WORKSHOPS AND REHABILITATION CENTERS. The department may receive and accept gifts and donations, including gifts and donations from persons benefited under this section, which may be offered unconditionally, for the purposes of establishing private, non-profit workshop and rehabilitation facilities for the rehabilitation of visually handicapped persons. All moneys received as gifts or donations shall be paid to the state treasurer and shall constitute a special account in the general fund to be used under the direction of the department for the vocational rehabilitation of persons qualifying for this purpose. A full report of such gifts and donations, together with the names of the donors, the amounts contributed by each and all disbursements therefrom shall be included in the annual report of the department.
