CHAPTER 129, LAWS OF 1967

AN ACT to create 20.670 (2) (Lg) of the statutes, and authorizing the state department of public welfare to sell to the state highway commission portions of state-owned lands connected to the Oregon state farm and Wisconsin school for girls.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. At the appropriate place in the schedule in section 20.005 of the statutes, insert the following amounts for the purposes indicated:

SECTION 2. 20.670 (2) (Lg) of the statutes is created to read:

20.670 (2) (Lg) *Sale of land.* Proceeds from the sale of land under chapter , laws of 1967 (Assembly Bill 612), for the purchase of other institutional farm land, including buildings, and for the remodeling or construction of buildings.

SECTION 3. The director of public welfare, with the approval of the governor, is authorized to sell to the state highway commission, 2 parcels of land on the east boundary of the present Wisconsin school for girls and Oregon state farm properties, situated in the town of Fitchburg, Dane county, and more particularly described in the right-of-way plat for state highway commission project T014-2(27), containing 32.5 acres, more or less.
