CHAPTER 178, LAWS OF 1967

AN ACT to authorize the state department of public welfare to sell to the conservation department portions of state-owned lands connected to the McNaughton state camp.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

The director of public welfare, with the approval of the governor, is authorized to sell to the conservation department for the sum of \$25 per acre that parcel of land, now a part of the premises of McNaughton state camp, in sections 9 and 10, township 38 north, range 7 east, consisting of N $\frac{1}{2}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said section 9 and N $\frac{1}{2}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said section 10, being south of county trunk D, containing approximately 160 acres. The proceeds of such sale shall be credited to the appropriation under section 20.670 (2) (g) of the statutes.
