CHAPTER 195, LAWS OF 1967

AN ACT to renumber 59.07 (30); and to create 59.07 (30) (b) of the statutes, relating to appropriations for advertisements dealing with radio and television events by counties over 500,000.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 59.07 (30) of the statutes is renumbered 59.07 (30) (a).

SECTION 2. 59.07 (30) (b) of the statutes is created to read:

59.07 (30) (b) In counties having a population of 500,000 or more, appropriate funds for the placing of advertisements in newspapers, periodicals or other publications listing radio and television broadcasting schedules, informing county residents of a radio or television appearance by a county official or employe, or advertising any program, function or activity sponsored by the county.
