CHAPTER 336, LAWS OF 1967

AN ACT to amend 29.148 (1) of the statutes, relating to the requirements for obtaining sturgeon spearing licenses.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

29.148 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

29.148 (1) Sturgeon spearing licenses shall be issued subject to s. 29.09 by designated civil service employes of the commission or by the county clerks, *for a fee of \$2.50*, on blanks furnished by the commission, to any person ~~of the age of 14 years or over~~ duly applying therefor. ~~The fee for each such license is \$2.50~~ who:

- (a) *Is 14 or 15 years of age;*
- (b) *Is at least 14 years of age and holds a sportsman's license issued under s. 29.147; or*
- (c) *Holds a resident fishing license issued under s. 29.145, or a non-resident fishing license issued under s. 29.14.*
