**CHAPTER 72, LAWS OF 1967**

AN ACT to authorize the department of public welfare to purchase certain lands in Racine county.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

Subject to approval of the governor, the department of public welfare is authorized to purchase 8 acres, more or less, of land in Racine county adjoining the southern Wisconsin colony and training school, said land being described as follows:

“Commencing at the Southwest corner of the Northwest Quarter of Section 30, Town 3 North, Range 21 East; thence North along the West

line of Section 30, 585 feet; thence East parallel to the South line of Quarter Section, 595 feet; thence South parallel to the West line of Section 30, 585 feet to a point on the Quarter Section line; thence West along the Quarter Section line, 595 feet to place of beginning, said land being situated in the county of Racine, state of Wisconsin.”.
