CHAPTER 80, LAWS OF 1967

AN ACT to amend 29.12 (4) (b) and 29.574 (7); and to create 29.574 (6m) of the statutes, eliminating the requirement of a hunting license for persons hunting on a game bird and animal farm.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 29.12 (4) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

29.12 (4) (b) Hunting at any time within the boundaries of a licensed ~~game bird and animal farm or deer farm~~ unprotected game ~~or game birds and animals~~, for which such ~~game bird and animal farm or deer farm~~ has been licensed under s. 29.574 or ~~s.~~ 29.578.

SECTION 2. 29.574 (6m) of the statutes is created to read:

29.574 (6m) Notwithstanding any other provision of the statutes to the contrary, no person hunting upon a game bird and animal farm shall be required to hold a hunting license.

SECTION 3. 29.574 (7) of the statutes is amended to read:

29.574 (7) Any person other than the licensee, his bona fide regular employes, or persons having permission from the licensee ~~who are otherwise qualified under chapter 29 to hunt thereon~~, who shall hunt or shoot game birds or animals upon any lands described in any such license, shall be liable to the licensee in the sum of \$100, in addition to all damage which he may do to ~~said the~~ farm or to the game birds or animals, and property thereon, but all actions for such trespass shall be brought by such licensee.
