CHAPTER 1, LAWS OF 1969

AN ACT to create 46.36 of the statutes, relating to the construction and utilization of a sanitary sewer system in the area adjacent to the Wisconsin home for women in the town of Taycheedah, Fond du Lac county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

46.36 of the statutes is created to read:

46.36 SEWER SYSTEM AT WISCONSIN HOME FOR WOMEN. The department of health and social services, with the approval of the governor, may enter into an agreement containing such terms, conditions and covenants as are approved by the building commission, to participate in the construction of a sanitary sewer system in the area adjacent to the Wisconsin home for women in the town of Taycheedah, Fond du Lac county; to connect the sewer system of the Wisconsin home for women thereto; to pay sewage disposal charges; and to grant easements or convey land to meet construction requirements.
