CHAPTER 135, LAWS OF 1969

AN ACT to appropriate \$2,814 from the highway fund for payment of a claim made by Walter Donahue against the state.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

There is appropriated from the highway fund \$2,814 to Walter Donahue to compensate him for damages resulting from an erroneous interpretation of federal requirements relating to interstate highways on the part of employees of the Wisconsin highway commission. As a result of such erroneous interpretation, Mr. Donahue incurred costs in the erection and subsequent removal of 7 outdoor advertising signs along Interstate 90 in Sauk county. Acceptance of this payment shall operate as a full and complete release of the state of any claim on account of such additional costs or loss of profits.
