**CHAPTER 163, LAWS OF 1969**

AN ACT to amend 29.09 (9) of the statutes, relating to disabled hunters.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly,  
do enact as follows:*

29.09 (9) of the statutes is amended to read:

29.09 (9) After proper application and presentation of a current hunting license duly issued to the applicant, the ~~conservation director~~ *secretary* may, after due investigation and without cost, grant a special permit to any person who is unable to walk ~~because of any affliction whatsoever~~ *and requires a wheel chair or prosthetic appliance for mobility*, to shoot or

hunt from a standing automobile ~~or to leave decoys in the water in front of his own property unattended~~ or to hunt any deer, whether a buck or a doe, during the regular deer season, notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter to the contrary. *Regardless of deer hunting party permit limits, any holder of a permit under this section may obtain a party permit deer tag without cost upon application in any area for which a party deer season has been established.*
