CHAPTER 185, LAWS OF 1969

AN ACT to amend 39.15 and 139.02 of the statutes, relating to studying funds for the Marquette school of medicine, inc., and making an appropriation to the Marquette school of medicine, inc.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1a. 39.15 (1) of the statutes, as created by chapter 3, laws of 1969, is amended to read:

39.15 (1) At such time as the governor directs, the Marquette school of medicine, inc., shall submit its budget request under s. 20.250 to him, and submit a copy thereof to the coordinating council for higher education. The coordinating council shall conduct a ~~biennial~~ program analysis *as provided by section 15.04 (4)* for those programs of the school which are supported in part by these state funds and include an advisory report on its findings and recommendations in its report under s. 15.04 (4). The legislative audit bureau shall biennially post-audit expenditures under s. 20.250

so as to assure the propriety of expenditures and compliance with legislative intent.

SECTION 1b. 139.02 of the statutes is amended to read:

139.02 ~~(1)~~ An occupational tax is imposed upon the removal for consumption or sale or selling of fermented malt beverages *on or before October 31, 1969* at the rate of \$1 per barrel of 31 gallons and at a proportionate rate for any other quantity or fractional parts thereof *and on and after November 1, 1969, at the rate of \$2 per barrel of 31 gallons and at a proportionate rate for any other quantity or fractional parts thereof and on and after November 1, 1969, rate increase shall not apply to floor stocks of fermented malt beverages at the close of business on October 31, 1969, of retailers and wholesalers other than brewers.* Not more than one occupational tax shall be required to be paid on any one container of fermented malt beverages.

SECTION 2. The appropriation under section 20.250 (1) (a) of the statutes, as affected by the laws of 1969, to the Marquette school of medicine, inc., is increased by \$1,500,000 for 1969-70 and by \$1,700,000 for 1970-71 to provide funds for general program operations at the school.
