CHAPTER 225, LAWS OF 1969

AN ACT to amend 247.101 of the statutes, relating to recrimination and comparative rectitude in actions for legal separation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

247.101 of the statutes is amended to read:

247.101 The equitable doctrine that the court shall not aid a wrongdoer is applicable to any party suing for divorce *or legal separation* under s. 247.07 (1) to (5), except that where it appears from the evidence that both parties have been guilty of misconduct sufficiently grave to constitute cause for divorce *or legal separation*, the court may ~~in its discretion~~ grant a judgment of legal separation to the party whose equities on the whole are found to be superior.
