CHAPTER 258, LAWS OF 1969

AN ACT to create chapter 396, laws of 1937, section 5 (3) (c), relating to duty disability payments for police or firemen in cities of the 1st class.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Chapter 396, laws of 1937, section 5 (3) (c) is created to read:

(Chapter 396, Laws of 1937) Section 5 (3) (c) Any policeman or fireman receiving duty disability payments from the employes retirement system shall be allowed to retain the whole of such payments notwithstanding his income from any nonservice related employment.
