CHAPTER 318, LAWS OF 1969

AN ACT to create 186.36 of the statutes, relating to the selling of insurance in credit unions.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

186.36 of the statutes is created to read:

186.36 SALE OF INSURANCE IN CREDIT UNIONS. Any agent who is an officer or employe of a credit union, may pay the whole or any part of his commissions from the sale of credit life insurance or credit accident and health insurance to the credit union.
