CHAPTER 417, LAWS OF 1969

AN ACT to create 172.015 of the statutes, relating to a penalty for letting livestock run at large on a highway.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

172.015 of the statutes is created to read:

172.015 LIVESTOCK ON HIGHWAYS; PENALTY. No livestock shall run at large on a highway at any time except to go from one farm parcel to another. If the owner or keeper of livestock knowingly permits livestock so to do and after notice by any peace officer fails to remove such livestock from the highway, he may be fined not exceeding \$200.
