CHAPTER 1, Laws of 1971

AN ACT to amend 8.50 (2) (b) of the statutes, relating to special election primaries.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

8.50 (2) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

8.50 (2) (b) The primary shall be on the day 4 weeks before the day of the special election except when the special election is held on the same day as the general election the special primary shall be held on the same day as the general primary or if the special election is held concurrently with the spring election, the primary shall be held concurrently with the spring primary.
