CHAPTER 5, Laws of 1971

AN ACT to appropriate \$1,239.50 from the general fund for payment of a claim made by Charles Androsky against the state.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

There is appropriated from the general fund \$1,239.50 to Charles Androsky to compensate him for expenses incurred because of the death of his brother Dennis in 1968 from stab wounds inflicted upon him by an inmate at the Green Bay reformatory. Acceptance of this appropriation shall operate as a full and complete release to the state of any claim on account of such death.
