EXECUTIVE COMMUNICATIONS GOVERNOR'S VETO MESSAGE

To the Honorable, the Assembly:

I am returning Assembly Bill 1057 with my partial approval. I have exercised the item veto on a technical appropriation provision of the bill.

Assembly Bill 1057 represents an important comprehensive step forward in protecting the rights of Wisconsin consumers. However, the bill contains in Section 1, a partial

reversal of state budget policy for program revenue-funded regulatory agencies. In addition, present statutory language set by the 1971-73 executive budget will allow the office of the Commissioner of Banking to fully administer the bill's provisions without the language I am vetoing. Retaining Section 1 would mean loss of general fund revenues of approximately \$31,000 in the 1971-73 biennium. For these reasons, I am striking the inconsistent language that appears in Section 1.
