CHAPTER 36 , Laws of 1973

AN ACT to authorize the town of Merrimac, in Sauk county, to hold a special referendum election on the sale of beer.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Notwithstanding the 2-year moratorium under section 176.38 of the statutes, the town board of the town of Merrimac, in Sauk county, may by a petition signed by 15% of the voters casting a ballot at the April 3, 1973, election, conduct a special
