To Members of Joint Committee for Review of Administrative Rules:

To Members of Assembly Committee of Health and Social Services:

The Health and Social Services Board adopted, on June 19, 1974 a proposal to "repeal and re-create" Chapter H 32, Wisconsin Administrative Code, pertaining to nursing home rules.

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In accordance with the requirement that the recreated rules stand before the appropriate committees of the Senate and of the Assembly for thirty days prior to final promulgation, I am herewith transmitting a full copy of the recreated Chapter H 32.

I recognize that a summary, as opposed to a full copy, is preferred. These particular rules, however, have been subject to challenge, defense, and protracted negotiation on a detailed basis for some four years.
