1975 **Assembly Resolution 30** requests my opinion on the constitutionality of 1975 **Senate Bill 399**.

**Senate Bill 399**, having failed to pass, is no longer a viable legislative proposal. This makes the question of its constitutionality moot.

For much the same reason that the Supreme Court advances in similar cases, this office historically and consistently has declined to treat moot issues. Therefore, I must respectfully decline to respond to **Assembly Resolution 30**.
