CHAPTER 241, Laws of 1977

AN ACT relating to authorizing and directing the department of natural resources to sell or exchange certain lands in Oneida county for the benefit of the state.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Lands exchanged. (1) The department of natural resources is authorized and directed to sell or exchange at private sale for fair market value for the benefit of the state the following described parcel of land: The northwest quarter of the northwest quarter of section 19, township 38 north, range 9 east and the northeast quarter of the northeast quarter of section 24, township 38 north, range 8 east, Oneida county, Wisconsin with Harley A. Butler and Lillian M. Butler for the following described parcel of land owned by Harley A. Butler and Lillian M. Butler: The northwest quarter of the southwest quarter, section 7, township 38 north, range 9 east, and the southeast quarter of the northwest quarter of section 24, township 38 north, range 8 east, Oneida county, Wisconsin.
