CHAPTER 38, Laws of 1977

AN ACT to create 59.877 of the statutes, relating to enabling legislation allowing a county having a population of 500,000 or more to license cats.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 59.877 of the statutes is created to read:

59.877 Licenses for cats. A county having a population of 500,000 or more may enact an ordinance requiring licenses for cats. The ordinance may require a person who owns or keeps a cat within the county's boundaries to pay a license fee, obtain a license tag and otherwise control the cat. All proceeds from cat licenses shall be used for licensing, regulating and impounding of cats.
