

CHAPTER 179, Laws of 1979

AN ACT to appropriate \$2,729.86 from the conservation fund for payment of a claim made by the city of West Allis against the state.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Claim against the state. There is appropriated \$2,729.86 from the conservation fund to the city of West Allis as reimbursement for a portion of the amount of forestation tax paid by the city to the state in 1975. The amount represents a portion of the property tax overpaid by the Allis-Chalmers corporation for 1975 as the result of an assessment error, plus interest. Acceptance of this payment operates as a full and complete release to the state for any claim by the city arising from any improper assessment of manufacturing property of the Allis-Chalmers corporation for 1975.
