**CHAPTER 195, Laws of 1979**

AN ACT to amend 66.054 (11) (c) of the statutes, relating to permitting municipalities to determine without restriction the fee which may be charged for a fermented malt beverage and intoxicating liquor "operator's license".

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. 66.054 (11) (c) of the statutes is amended to read:

66.054 (11) (c) ~~The fee for an An operator's license shall not exceed \$5 per year,~~ shall be issued for one year, and shall expire on June 30 of the year for which issued, except for ~~cities of the first class~~ 1st class cities in which ~~such~~ the operator's license shall expire on December 31. The city council, village board or town board shall establish the fee for an operator's license by ordinance.
