To the Governor and Members of the Legislature:

The Legislative Audit Bureau (LAB) is a nonpartisan service agency of the Legislature, with its current statutory authority appearing at s. 13.94, Wis. Stats. The Bureau is headed by the State Auditor, who is appointed by the Joint Committee on Legislative Organization.

Under s. 13.53, Wis. Stats., the Joint Legislative Audit Committee (JAC) exercises advisory responsibilities with respect to the LAB, holds public hearings on Bureau reports, and introduces legislation to correct deficiencies identified in state agency operations. Committee members (4 from the Senate and 4 from the Assembly) are appointed in the same manner as are members of standing committees, and includes equal representation from each of the major political parties.

A copy of this biennial report and summary of the activities of LAB, as required by s. 13.94(1)(j), Wis. Stats. can be obtained in Room 131 A, South.
