CHAPTER 23, Laws of 1981

AN ACT to amend 66.054 (11) (c) of the statutes, relating to allowing municipalities to issue either annual or biennial bartenders' licenses.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. 66.054 (11) (c) of the statutes is amended to read:

66.054 (11) (c) An operator's license shall be issued for one year or 2 years, as determined by the governing body of the city, village or town, and shall expire on June 30 of the year period for which issued, except for 1st class cities in which the operator's license shall expire on December 31. The city council, village board or town board shall establish the fee for an operator's license by ordinance.
