## CHAPTER 242, Laws of 1981

AN ACT relating to conveying certain submerged lands to the city of Sheboygan.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Grant. The state of Wisconsin cedes, grants and conveys to the city of Sheboygan, a municipal corporation, all rights, title and interest to all of the land and any part or parcel of the lands described under Section 2 of this act to be held and used by the city for dredge spoil containment and for future development for public slips, basins, docks, wharves, structures, wildlife refuges, recreation or park purposes.

SECTION 2. Description. The lands granted to the city of Sheboygan under this act include submerged lands under the waters of Lake Michigan and any dry lands which exist or may be created and are described as follows: A tract of land in Lake Michigan lying along and adjacent to lands ceded by the state of Wisconsin to the city of Sheboygan by chapter 424, laws of 1933, approved July 14, 1933, and published July 15, 1933, and by chapter 451, laws of 1947, approved July 30, 1947, and published July 30, 1947, and more particularly described as follows: A tract of submerged land in Lake Michigan lying along and adjacent to submerged lands ceded by the state of Wisconsin to the city of Sheboygan by chapter 424, laws of 1933, and by chapter 451, laws of 1947 and more particularly described as follows:

A tract of submerged land bounded on the west by the easterly line of the 1,700 feet of submerged land ceded to the city of Sheboygan by chapter 424, laws of 1933, and by chapter 451, laws of 1947; bounded on the east by a line passing through a point at state plane coordinates N. 646,632.1, E. 2,608,776.8, this line being 580.0 feet, more or less, easterly of and parallel with the western boundary; bounded on the north by the centerline of Washington court in the city of Sheboygan extended easterly; bounded on the south by the centerline of Center avenue in the city of Sheboygan extended easterly; except that this tract

of submerged land does not include any land lying northeasterly of a line commencing at state plane coordinates N. 646,905.34, E. 2,608,859.84 extending N. 45 degrees, 46 minutes, 2 seconds W. to the northern boundary; and except that this tract of submerged land does not include any land lying southeasterly of a line commencing at state plane coordinates N. 646,905.34 and E. 2,608,859.84 extending S. 44 degrees, 13 minutes, 58 seconds W. to the southern boundary.
