**CHAPTER 273 , Laws of 1981**

**AN ACT** to create 118.125 (1) (d) and (2) (j) of the statutes, relating to creating an exception to the confidentiality of pupil records for directory data.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

**SECTION 1.** 118.125 (1) (d) and (2) (j) of the statutes are created to read:

118.125 (1) (d) "Directory data" means those pupil records which include the pupil's name, address, telephone listing, date and place of birth, major field of study, participation in officially recognized activities and sports, weight and height of members of athletic teams, dates of attendance, photographs, degrees and awards received and the name of the school most recently previously attended by the pupil.

(2) (j) Directory data may be disclosed to any person, if the school has given public notice of the categories of information which it has designated as directory data with respect to each pupil and has allowed a reasonable time thereafter for the parent, legal guardian or guardian ad litem of any pupil to inform the school that all or any part of the directory data may not be released without the prior consent of the parent, legal guardian or guardian ad litem.
