*A Proclamation*

I, Lee Sherman Dreyfus, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to Section 11 of Article IV and Section 4 of Article V of the Constitution of Wisconsin, do hereby require the convening of a special session of the Legislature to take place at the Capitol in Madison on Wednesday, the 28th day of April, A.D., 1982, at 10:00 A.M., solely for the purpose of considering and acting upon the following specific pieces of legislative business, to-wit:

1. Granting authority to the governor to reduce any or all appropriations up to 10% within the biennium.
2. Granting authority to the governor to reduce employee salaries as necessary by reducing or eliminating 1982-83 increases for all state employees or by layoffs.
3. Transferring school aid payment or part thereof from June 1981-82 to July 1982-83.
4. Setting the salaries of state officials elected at the 1982 general elections at the salary rates effective for 1978-79.
