1983 Wisconsin Act 240

AN ACT to authorize and direct expenditure of \$20,607.02 from the general fund for payment of 7 claims against the state made by Robert Cannon, Leander Foley, Jr., Hugh O'Connell, Robert Landry, John Decker, Robert Curley and Christ Seraphim.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Claim against the state. There is authorized and directed to be expended from the appropriation under section 20.505 (4) (d) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 1983, \$20,607.02 in payment of 7 claims against the state made by Robert Cannon, Leander Foley, Jr., Hugh O'Connell, Robert Landry, John Decker, Robert Curley and Christ Seraphim. From this amount, each claimant under this act shall be paid \$2,943.86. This payment is made for reimbursement of attorney fees and costs incurred in challenging the constitutionality of section 40.91, 1979 stats., relating to offset of retirement benefits against current salaries. Acceptance of this payment operates as a full and complete release to the state for any claim resulting from expenses incurred by the claimants in challenging the constitutionality of this enactment.
