1983 Wisconsin Act 313

AN ACT to authorize and direct expenditure of \$10,333.70 from moneys appropriated to the department of transportation for payment of a claim against the state made by Daniel Hannula.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Claim against the state. There is authorized and directed to be expended from the appropriation under section 20.395 (3) (cq) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 1983, \$10,333.70 in payment of a claim against the state made by Daniel Hannula, Superior, Wisconsin, to compensate him for attorney fees and disbursements incurred in an eminent domain action in which the award of the department of transportation was appealed by the landowners. The claimant's contract with the department, dated November 27, 1981, did not provide for payment of this amount. Acceptance of this payment operates as a full and complete release to the state for any claim arising from services performed in connection with the aforementioned action in which the claimant provided legal services on behalf of the state.
