1981 Senate Joint Resolution 58 requested the Judicial Council to study Wisconsin's venue laws and report its findings and recommendations to the 1983 Legislature.

Pursuant to that request, the Judicial Council established a Venue Committee chaired by Attorney Thomas Curran of Mauston and assisted by Professor Thomas Cannon of the University of Marquette Law School. The committee's findings and recommendations, as shown by the enclosed bill (LRB 3154/5), were approved by the Judicial Council on May 20, 1983.

Enactment of this bill will fulfill the intent of the Joint Resolution to clarify and simplify the statutes, accommodate the convenience of litigants and witnesses, discourage forum shopping and promote the ends of justice.
