A Proclamation

I, Anthony S. Earl, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to Section 11 of Article IV and section 4 of Article V of the Constitution of Wisconsin, do amend Executive Order 55, requiring the convening of a special session of the Legislature at the Capitol in Madison, beginning on May 22, 1984 at 10:00 A.M. by adding to its business considering and acting upon the following specific legislative business:

1. Changing eligibility standards and setting income limitations for the financial assistance program for septic system replacement and

rehabilitation.

- 2. Renumbering certain definitions related to taxation and authorizing the revisor of statutes bureau to make nonsubstantive corrections in administrative rules.
- 3. Making an appropriation for membership dues and related expenses for the Midwest Interstate Low-level Radioactive Waste Compact.
